CAMP TIMANOUS UNIFORM AND EQUIPMENT LIST

Required Official Camp Uniform:

The campers must wear a uniform at all times. They may wear jeans with a camp T-shirt. The number of each item is suggested to provide them with a week's worth of "clean" uniforms, as the laundry is done weekly. For more details, please refer to pages 5-8 of the camper handbook.

_____ 6 Pairs of Timanous Shorts (at least 1 or 2 must be gray camp shorts with green stripe, aka "dress shorts")

_____ 6 Timanous Short Sleeve Tee Shirts (at least 2 must be the "Ringer Tee")

_____ 1 Pair Gray or Green Timanous Sweatpants

_____ 2 Warm Shirts (choice of Timanous Crewneck Sweatshirt, Hooded Sweatshirt, Fleece Zip-up)

The following items are necessary accessories to the camp uniform and for the cabin:

_____ 10 pair of underwear

_____ 2 pairs of pajamas (or appropriate sleepwear)

_____ 10 pairs of socks

_____ 1 raincoat (**essential**)

_____ 1 pair of waterproof boots or shoes

_____ 2 pair of sneakers

_____ 4 to 6 quick-dry towels

_____ 2 bathing suits

_____ 1 pillow & 2 pillow cases

_____ 4 sheets for twin or cot bed (2 should be fitted)

_____ 2 Timanous mesh laundry bags (available at Maine Camp Outfitters)

_____ 3 warm blankets for a single bed or a combination of blankets & quilts. Boys may not sleep in their sleeping bags except on camping trips, but an open sleeping bag may be used as a quilt. (Wool blankets may be borrowed from camp.)

All campers should have the following items for camping trips (most are also frequently used while at camp):

_____ 2 water bottles

_____ 1 flashlight

_____ Packable sleeping bag *with* compression stuff sack

_____ Sleeping pad

_____ Dedicated water shoes (if sandals, they must have straps; flip flops and slides are not appropriate for camping)

A good sleeping bag and sleeping pad are great investments in your camper's many years of Timanous camping trips and are necessary for effective packing, trip comfort and safety. We do have a limited supply for borrowing as needed.

_____ 1 Heavy sweater or warm jacket

_____ Toiletry kit and contents

_____ Long Sleeve Camp T-shirt

_____ Tennis racquet*

_____ Jeans

_____ Bug repellent (not spray)

_____ Sleeping bag (may be borrowed for camping trips)

_____ Nail Clippers

_____ Sleeping pad (may be borrowed for camping trips)

_____ Swim Goggles

_____ Baseball glove*

_____ Fishing Rod

_____ Soccer cleats & shin guard

_____ Rain Pants

_____ Lacrosse Equipment*

_____ Flip flops / Slides / Crocs

_____ Watch (battery-operated, non-smart) w/ alarm

_____ Portable Hammock (with tree straps)

_____ Reading books

_____ Small portable fan (battery-operated preferred)

* Sports equipment is available for use at the camp, but boys may want to bring their own.
