

2021 TRAVEL INFORMATION

ARRIVALS

June 24 (*full and 1st session*) or **July 19** (*2nd session*)

We strongly recommend traveling directly from home to Timanous on the first day of your session if at all possible, avoiding stops that can lead to exposure. Families traveling from great distances may want to consider early travel to Maine and securing testing in Maine upon arrival. Air travel necessitated by distance is acceptable but we encourage car travel whenever possible. We will be able to greet campers at Boston Logan Airport or the Portland Jetport when air travel is necessary. At this time we do not anticipate offering a bus from the New York region.

DRIVING

We plan to stagger camper drop-offs between **12PM and 4:30PM on both arrival days**. We will send out a signup form where you can choose a slot that works best for you. Please note this is a change from past years. Lunch will not be offered at Timanous so please pack your own lunch for the car.

SHIPPING CAMP TRUNKS ENCOURAGED

For 2021, we encourage families to ship trunks in advance when traveling from out-of-state. As drop-off will be brief this year, it is far better to ship the trunk and have it in place when the campers arrive. Having fewer items to deliver to the cabin on opening day will ease the drop off process. If driving your child to camp, you may bring the trunk with you. Trunks may arrive up to 2 weeks prior to your son's arrival. Please ship trunks to: Camp Timanous, 85 Plains Road, Raymond, ME 04071. We can arrange to have trunks shipped home at the end of camp.

FLYING - if necessitated by distance from camp

We will arrange to meet campers at Portland or Logan airports. Logan is primarily for international campers. **Please check in with us prior to making your flight reservations so that we can best coordinate camper travel to and from the airport.** As soon as you know your flight, let us know so that we may recommend it to others from the same area. It is nice if campers can travel together.

PORTLAND, MAINE JETPORT (PWM)

\$40

Campers will be met at their flights by our counselors and brought to camp by car. Flight arrival time on **Thursday, June 24 and Monday, July 19** should be between 12PM and 4PM. Departures on **Sunday, July 18** should be scheduled for the morning. At the end of camp, departures can be scheduled for late (5:30PM or later) **Wednesday, August 11** or before noon on **Thursday, August 12**.

LOGAN AIRPORT, BOSTON, MASSACHUSETTS (BOS)

\$120

Campers will be met at their flight by our counselors and driven to camp. Flight arrival times on **Thursday, June 24 and Sunday, July 19** should be scheduled between 2PM and 6PM. Flight departures on **Sunday, July 18** should be scheduled **between 2PM and 6PM**. Flight departures on **Thursday, August 12** should be scheduled **between NOON and 4PM**.

DEPARTURES

July 17 (1st session) or August 11 (full and 2nd session)

Please note that due to our inability to host visitors at camp this summer, families will not be able to attend our end-of-session ceremonies of Council Fire and Banquet when picking up campers.

DRIVING

Similar to arrival, we plan to offer staggered pickup times from **2:30PM to 4:00PM on both departure days**. We will circulate a signup form later in the spring. All campers except those traveling by plane will depart at this time following our closing ceremonies.

If you are picking up your camper after the 1st session on Saturday, July 18 — keep in mind that weekend traffic coming north to Maine and around Raymond can be very heavy on summer weekends, so please plan accordingly.

CAMP TRUNKS AND OTHER BAGGAGE

Your son's luggage can be shipped home at the end of his session. The UPS Store (formerly Mailboxes, Etc.) will come to Timanous at the end of each session to prepare, label and ship all baggage. All trunks will be boxed. Shipping charges will be added on to your final invoice statement.

As the cost of shipping trunks internationally is prohibitive, international campers may store trunks or boxes at camp for the following summer.

FLYING

We will arrange to take campers to Portland or Logan airports. Logan is primarily for international campers but maybe used for domestic flights if it insures a direct flight.

PORTLAND, MAINE JETPORT (PWM)

\$40

First session campers should plan to depart **Sunday morning, July 19th** and full time and second session campers on **Wednesday evening, August 11th** or **Thursday morning, August 12th**.

LOGAN AIRPORT, BOSTON, MASSACHUSETTS (BOS)

\$120

First half camper's flights should be scheduled for **Sunday, July 19th between 2PM and 6PM**. Full time and Second session campers flights should be scheduled for **Thursday, August 12th between NOON and 4PM**. (there may be an extra charge if flights are not during these times and require extra counselor coverage)
