



TIMANOUS UNIFORM & EQUIPMENT

All Timanous campers wear uniforms. The catalog from our uniform supplier, Maine Camp Outfitters, contains all the required and optional clothing for a summer at Timanous, and is linked on the Summer FAQ page of our website. Please use our list titled “Camp Timanous Uniform and Equipment List” as your guide for required clothing and **please attach a completed form to the inside of the trunk or bring it with you on opening day**. Shipping

If shipping luggage, UPS or FedEx can send baggage at least two weeks before the start of camp directly to Camp Timanous, 85 Plains Road, Raymond, ME 04071. A sturdy trunk has been found to be the most suitable container as it can be placed beside a camper's bed and used for storage during the summer. Trunks shipped to camp will be placed in the cabin, next to your camper's bunk before arrival. You are more than welcome to bring the trunk with you. Nametags

Camp clothes look the same. All items must be labeled clearly and permanently with names. You would be amazed how many items are left at the end of the summer. We return everything of value that is labeled but there are always a lot of items that we cannot return either because they were never labeled or the labels have come off. Please make sure everything is well labeled. Beware of labels that might fall off in the laundry!

Laundry

The laundry goes out every Monday and is returned the next day. Boys need enough uniforms to get through a week of rugged outdoor use. **The boys must have 2 Official Camp Timanous laundry bags with their name clearly written on the front.** The camp laundry bag is available from Maine Camp Outfitters.

Towels

Campers should bring several small- or medium-sized, fast-drying towels. We find that the large, thick towels do not dry easily either when hanging on the clothesline or in the dryer at the laundry. Because the laundry does each camper's laundry as one load, the larger, thicker towels either come back damp or the rest of the laundry is slightly cooked. Towels which remain damp are unsanitary, so we are suggesting that campers bring enough towels to use a new one each day and encourage the use of smaller and fast drying towels. Please make sure the towels are well labeled with your camper's name.

Electronics

Please leave phones, iPads, Kindles, Apple Watch, Electronic Games, etc. at home. Acoustic instruments are welcome.

Books

We provide quiet time to read and relax in the cabins so boys have many opportunities to read.

The Camp Store

The “store” is a small closet in the office where boys can obtain small necessities like toothbrushes, toothpaste, batteries, etc. You do not need to send any money. Invoices will be sent at the end of the summer if your son has accumulated a balance at the store.

Camp Timanous Uniform and Equipment List

Required Official Camp Uniform:

The campers must wear a uniform at all times – the only exception being that they may wear jeans with a camp T-shirt. The number of each item is suggested to provide them with a week's worth of "clean" uniforms as the laundry is done weekly. For more details, please refer to pages 5-8 of the camper handbook.

_____ 6 Pairs of Timanous Shorts (at least 1 or 2 must be gray camp short with green stripe)

_____ 6 Timanous Short Sleeve Tee Shirts (at least 2 must be the "Ringer Tee")

_____ 1 Pair Gray or Green Timanous Sweatpants

_____ 2 Warm Shirts (choice of Timanous Crewneck Sweatshirt, Hooded Sweatshirt, Fleece Zip-up)

_____ 2 Camp Timanous Green laundry bags (Our laundry company requires campers to use "official" laundry bags which are available from Maine Camp Outfitters). Please write camper's name on outside of bag.

The following items are necessary accessories to the camp uniform:

Please be prepared to send your camper with the type and amount of face masks that we will recommend later in the spring, based on the most up-to-date research and guidance on appropriate COVID-19 protocols.

_____ 10 pair of underwear

_____ 2 pairs of pajamas (or appropriate sleepwear)

_____ 10 pairs of socks

_____ 1 raincoat (**essential**)

_____ 1 waterproof boots or shoes

_____ 2 pair of sneakers

_____ 4 to 6 towels (please see separate note on towels)

_____ 2 bathing suits

_____ 1 pillow & 2 pillow cases

_____ 4 sheets for twin or cot bed (2 should be fitted)

_____ 3 warm blankets for single bed or a combination of blankets & quilts. Boys may not sleep in their sleeping bags except on camping trips, but an open sleeping bag may be used as a quilt. (Wool blankets may be rented from camp)

All campers should have the following items for camping trips (most are also frequently used while at camp):

_____ 2 water bottles

_____ 1 flashlight

_____ Packable sleeping bag *with* compression stuff sack

_____ Sleeping pad

_____ Dedicated water shoes (if sandals, must have straps; flip flops and slides are not appropriate for camping)

A good sleeping bag and sleeping pad are great investments in your camper's many years of Timanous camping trips, and are necessary for effective packing and trip comfort and safety. We do have a limited supply for rent as needed.

_____ Fishing Rod

_____ Soccer cleats & shin guard

_____ Rain Pants

_____ Lacrosse Equipment (see Camper Handbook)*

_____ Flip flops / Slides / Crocs
